# Rules and Regulations for CFU National TenPin Bowling Tournament 

## HANDICAP ALLOWANCES

MEN:--Handicap will be $100 \%$ up to 75
pins per game.
WOMEN: Handicap will be the $100 \%$
up to 100 pins per game.

## Read Carefully Information Given Below

## NAME

This tournament shall be known as the Annual CFU National Bowling Tournament under the auspices of the Croatian Fraternal Union of America and open to all Lodges and members of the CFU.

## ELIGIBILITY

All CFU members who are in good standing of said Society, prior to the deadline of entry date are eligible to bowl in the tournament upon payment of the prescribed entry and bowling fees.

## ENTRIES

1. Entries must be in the hands of the Secretary on or before the closing date. Absolutely no entries accepted unless accompanied by the full amount of entry and bowling fees.
2. Each bowler may participate only once in this tournament.

## PRIZE RATIO: Approximately 1 to 6 . Prize Fees awarded will be $100 \%$ of Prize Fund.

## HANDICAP AND AVERAGE

1. Handicap for men will be figured on a basis of $100 \%$ up to 75 pins per game, for women $100 \%$ up to 100 pins per game.
2. Individual averages must be based on a minimum of 21 games in a USBC league. Averages established in USBC leagues which start its schedules after March 15 for the summer season shall be accepted as official, provided the bowler does not have an acceptable regular season average. (USBC Rule 319a \#1)
3. When the previous season's average is used, and at the time of bowling an entrant has a current average for 21 or more games that is 10 points higher than the previous season's average, the current average must be used. (USBC Rule 319a \#2)
4. Individual averages must be based on a minimum of 21 games in a USBC certified league. All bowlers who do not have a USBC certified league average and have previously bowled in a CFU tournament will be given there previous CFU tournament average. Bowlers with no established league or CFU average will be given an average of 135 for women and 155 for men.
5. Teams or individuals may be disqualified for submitting incorrect averages or for violation of any tournament rule.
6. Each bowler is responsible for keeping a record of the names, dates, scores and prize winnings in all tournaments entered in the previous 12 months, including those still running. These include all tournament scores bowled in accordance with the game of American Tenpins. (USBC Rule 319e \#1)
7. A bowler shall adjust his/her entering average if, during the 12-month period immediately preceding the time and date of bowling, the bowler's accumulated average for all, but not less than 21 tournament games, exceeds the average to be used for entry by 15 or more pins. In that case, the accumulated average must be used for handicapping or classification purposes. (USBC Rule 319e \#2)
8. It shall be each bowler's responsibility to verify the accuracy of his/her average in a handicap tournament. Whether originally submitted by the bowler, the team captain or others. Failure to use the proper average or make a correction up to the completion of the first game of a series or a at a time of bowling shall disqualify score if submitted average is lower than the actual average or base prize winnings on a submitted average if it is higher.

NOTE: Team captains must report to the Tournament Secretary 30 minutes prior to the scheduled bowling time. Failure to appear at the scheduled time will forfeit entry.
